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"Act now or your account will be closed!"

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[Click here:](#) Hover over links: They don't go where they claim to go.

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Regards - Customer service

Stop. Think.
Check before you click.

Be cautious: They could contain malware.

Unusual sender address

Generic greeting

Urgent or threatening language

Suspicious links
